Tuesday, October 11, 2016 is the last day for Florida voters to register to vote for the November 8, 2016 Presidential General Election. Citrus County's voter registration is at a record high at over 104,100. Over 1,000 new voters have registered since the August 1, 2016 registration deadline for the Primary Election. We encourage anyone who is not registered yet to do so before the General Election registration deadline of October 11, 2016.

## There are three (3) options for casting your ballot.

⇒ Voting by Mail - Convenience, no lines, no waiting.



- ⇒ Early Voting Four locations for 13 days, each day 12 hours 7am -7pm.
- ⇒ **Precinct/Election Day** Experience the actual day of the voting process.

All voters will be required to present a valid photo and signature ID to participate in Early and Election Day voting. Voting by mail requires a current signature on file because all vote by mail ballot certificates must be signed and will be compared to the signature on file. ## SAMPLE BALLOTS

A sample ballot will be mailed to all voters who do not have a vote-by-mail request on file. You only receive your sample ballot if your address is up-to-date at the elections' office.

All voters are encouraged to review the ballot beforehand, particularly the proposed amendments to the constitution. You can take your marked sample ballot with you to the polls or when early voting. If voting on Election Day, your sample ballot has your precinct and polling place information.

Your Voter Registration Information card is not required when voting. Lack of photo and signature ID will require the voter to cast a provisional ballot.
