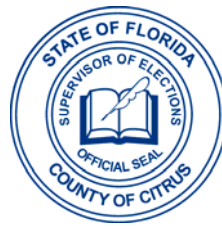

Candidates for the offices listed below qualify and file their campaign reports with the Citrus County Supervisor of Elections. **Florida law requires that all candidates must file an *Appointment of Treasurer and Designation of Depository* before collecting or spending any money on behalf of their campaign.**

OFFICES UP FOR ELECTION IN CITRUS COUNTY

COUNTY COMMISSION (Partisan)

Term: 4 Years
Qualifying Fee: \$3,411.72 Major Party (6% of annual salary of \$56,862)
\$2,274.48 Minor Party (4% of annual salary of \$56,862)
Petition Signatures: 1,027
District 2 (Gary Bartell incumbent)
District 4 (John Thrumston incumbent)

Requirements: Residency requirement: Per F.S. 100.041 a candidate must reside in the County Commission District from which he/she seeks to be elected on the date that the county canvassing board certifies the results of the election pursuant to F.S. 102.151.

SCHOOL BOARD (Non-partisan)

Term: 4 Years
Qualifying Fee: \$1,285.28 (4% of annual salary of \$32,132)
Petition Signatures: 1,027
District 1 (Louis A. Miele incumbent)
District 3 (Pat Deutschman incumbent)
District 5 (Linda Powers incumbent)

Requirements: Residency requirement: Must reside in District at time of qualifying.

COUNTY COURT JUDGE (Non-partisan)

(Mark J. Yerman incumbent)

Term: 6 Years
Qualifying Fee: \$5,371.20 (4% of annual salary of \$134,280)
Petition Signatures: 1,027

MOSQUITO CONTROL (Non-partisan)

Term: 4Years
Qualifying Fee: \$25.00 (99.061(3))
Petition Signatures: 25 (F.S.99.095(b))

District 1 (Brenda Buzby incumbent)
District 2 (Ken Frink incumbent)
District 3 (Bev Davis incumbent)

HOMOSASSA SPECIAL WATER DISTRICT (Non-partisan)

Term: 4 Years
Qualifying Fee: \$25.00
Petition Signatures: 25 (F.S.99.095(b))
 Seat 2 (Dennis Siebert incumbent)
 Seat 4 (Jim Bitter incumbent)

Qualifying for all County elections begins Noon, June 14, 2010 and ends Noon June 18, 2010. You may declare your candidacy at any time prior to these dates, but you must file your *Appointment of Campaign Treasurer and Designation of Depository* before you collect or spend any money.

Florida law provides two methods for qualifying for a county office:

- 1) Payment of the qualifying fee during the week of qualifying.**
- 2) Petition to qualify by the Alternative Method.**

Petitioning is done by collecting the specified number of signatures.

Candidates must submit petitions for verification to Supervisor of Elections.

As provided by law the Supervisor of Elections shall be paid in advance the sum of, (\$102.70) 10 cents for each signature checked. (Paid by Campaign check only)

Deadline for submitting petitions for verification is **prior to noon, May 17, 2010.**
