#### **Requirement for Voters**

You must show a valid photo and signature ID when voting early or at the polls on Election Day. Voters who do not show a valid photo and signature ID <u>must</u> vote a provisional ballot (F.S. 101.043 (2)).

#### Has Your Signature Changed Since You First Registered?

Signatures on mail ballots are checked against your most recent signature on file. Update your signature by completing a voter registration application and delivering it to the Supervisor of Elections Office.
