Susan Gill was elected to the office of Citrus County Supervisor of Elections in 1996. She was re-elected without opposition in 2000, 2004, 2008, 2012 and 2016.

Ms. Gill is an active member of the Florida State Association of Supervisors of Elections serving as the FSASE president in 2005-2006. She has served as the chair of the Rules and Legislative committees and is currently the co-chair of the FSASE Vote Center Task Force.

Ms. Gill has served on the State of Florida Help America Vote Act (HAVA) Planning Committee and the Election Assistance Commission workgroup to create the Vote by Mail/Absentee Ballot Election Management Guidelines in 2007.

She is a Florida State Certified Supervisor of Elections, a Master Florida Certified Election Professional (MFCEP) and is a graduate of the National Election Center's Certified Election and Registration Administrator (CERA) program. She is currently serving on the Board of Directors of the National Election Center. She served on the Research Alliance for Accessible Voting (RAAV) Committee sponsored by the Federal Elections Assistance Commission.

Ms. Gill is active in her community and has served on a number of community boards to include the College of Central Florida Foundation Board, the Citrus Memorial Health Systems Citizens Advisory Council.
